Fill out the information marked with a red asterisk, and then click next. Mark the last button: Housing Only. Click next to bypass Pre and Post Sessions. Click next to bypass Registrant Summary (registering another person). Agree to the conditions. Click next again.

On the Room Search screen, enter your arrival and departure dates and click Search Hotels. Our group hotel, The Westin Peachtree Plaza, will be listed at the top of the list. Click View Rooms. Click Reserve and agree with the cancellation policy.

On the Room Occupants page, scroll down and click Add Guest in order to add yourself (and others, if needed) to the room reservation. After the hotel is selected and occupant information entered, you must continue through the check out and guarantee process to guarantee your reservation with a credit card.

IMPORTANT DATES

June 23: Hotel Reservation Deadline

AADB's block of rooms will be held until **Friday, June 23, 2017**, or until rooms are exhausted. After June 23 or once rooms are exhausted – whichever occurs first – rooms will be available on a "space available" basis at the AADB hotel or nearby hotels. **For this reason, we strongly encourage you to complete online housing as soon as possible.**

September 29: Hotel Reservation Changes & Cancellation Deadline

Should you need to change your reservation, changes must be received in writing by Experient before 5 p.m. US Central Time, Friday, September 29, 2017. Email ada@experient-inc.com.

Should you need to cancel your reservation, your cancellation must be received in writing by Experient before 5 p.m. US Central Time, Friday, September 29, 2017. Email ada@experient-inc.com. After September 29, hotel cancellations may incur one night's room and tax charges direct from the hotel.

NOTE: Failure to check-in to your hotel on the confirmed date of arrival may result in one night's room and tax charges direct from the hotel.

October 4: Late Reservation Changes Deadline

On or after Wednesday, October 4, 2017, hotel reservation changes must be made directly with the hotel.

AADB MEETING REGISTRATION

The registration fee for the AADB meeting is \$450 for AADB members; \$600 for nonmembers. This fee is designed to cover, among other expenses, costs of meeting materials, the Tuesday President's Reception for both the registrant and one guest, and the Wednesday Banquet Luncheon for the registrant only. Guests are welcome at the Banquet Luncheon, but a separate fee is required.

Advance registration is advisable. If the AADB Central Office does not receive payment by September 1, 2017, a late fee of \$50 is required.
