Dr. R. Lamont (Monty) MacNeil has been Dean at the University of Connecticut School of Dental Medicine since January 2007. He holds a DDS degree from Dalhousie University, Canada (1980) and a certificate of advanced education in Periodontics and a Master of Dental Science degree from the University of Connecticut, USA (1989). He has held academic positions at several dental schools and has published extensively on the cellular and molecular mechanisms regulating tooth development, periodontal wound healing and tissue regeneration.
