He is currently President of the International Test Commission, President of the Assessment and Evaluation division of the International Association of Applied Psychology, and President-elect of the American Psychological Association's Division of Measurement, Evaluation and Statistics. He has edited or co-edited the *Psychological Testing of Hispanics and Test Interpretation and Diversity*, *High Stakes Testing in Education*, *Handbook of Testing and Assessment in Psychology* (3 volumes) and *Psychological Testing of Hispanics: Clinical, Intellectual, and Cultural Issues*, all with American Psychological Association books and the 17th, 18th, 19th and 20th *Mental Measurements Yearbooks*, *Pruebas Publicadas en Espanol*, and *Tests in Print VIII* and *Test in Print IX*. He was also co-editor of the *ITC Handbook of Testing and Assessment*. He has publishing more than 150 papers and has served on the APA Board of Directors, APA's Good Governance Committee, the APA Council of Representatives, and its International Relations in Psychology and Psychological Assessment and Testing committees and the ITC Council.
